


Christmas Shopping for the M&GN Enthusiast

Several members have been asking for information about the Circle's recently re-issued Booklets 1 and 3 – the Track Surveys of the N&S Joint and the Western Section of the M&GN. To give you an idea of their contents, we have scanned a couple of sample pages below. For the modeller, they are an invaluable source of information for measuring, scaling and positioning all the key civil engineering features and structures for your M&GN layout, including stations, platforms, goods sheds, signal boxes, gradient and mileposts, level crossings and bridges. The more significant junctions (e.g. Lowestoft Line Junction, Cuckoo Junction) and goods yards (e.g. South Lynn, Wisbech, Holbeach) are covered individually in more precise detail. For the more energetic of you who enjoy walking the trackbeds, there's a wealth of detail to help you identify remaining structures. Each booklet has been upgraded to better quality paper, metal spiral binding, and 'clarifoiled' card front and back covers. Your editor has both editions of booklet 3, and the difference in print quality between the old and new editions is quite remarkable.
